PLANT SUPERINTENDENT

The Sherwood Forest Water Company (SFWC) Plant Superintendent will be responsible for the full operation, functioning and management of the Class IV water plant and distribution system servicing 350 connections in a private, residential community. Note that the SFWC has no waste-water treatment responsibilities, allowing its staff to focus on delivering clean, safe drinking water to the community.

The Plant Superintendent must know and be able to perform the responsibilities of a Plant Operator, including, but not limited to the following:

- Have or secure a Water System Class IV Operator certification
- Test water on daily basis in accordance with Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE)
- Be responsible for the supply and resupply of chemicals and other supplies.
- Run all aspects of the water plant, including pumping, treatment, filtering and transmission to the water tower
- Clean floc tanks, backwash filters, flush mains on regular cycle
- Repair minor leaks in the distribution system
- Monitor pumps and other plant equipment
- Maintain records associated with plant operations
- Locate and mark water lines as required by Miss Utility
- Maintain facility grounds and buildings
- Maintain and repair of basic motors, pumps, and other various equipment
- Move 50-pound lime bags and 100 pound chlorine tanks
- Employee will be available for emergency calls as needed

The Superintendent's role also will include additional duties, including, but not limited to the following:

- Supervise Plant Operator(s)
- Ensure compliance with Federal and State reporting and testing requirements
- Develop plans for, and implement improvements to, water plant and distribution system
- Prepare budget estimates of time and materials for plant and distribution system improvements
- Identify, hire, and manage qualified contractors for support of operations or capital projects
- Make recommendations regarding purchase of new equipment and modifications of existing equipment,
- Define and implement improvements in methods and procedures of operations
- Assure the quality of the water, answer inquiries on taste or discoloration of water, and take appropriate corrective measures as necessary
- Develop and maintain policies and procedures regarding water plant operations, equipment maintenance, distribution system operation and maintenance
- Update and maintain an accurate mapping of distribution system

• Develop and implement Cross Connection Control Plan

- Must have ability to be courteous, diplomatic, and respectful
- Ability to act quickly and independently in operational emergencies
- Ability to organize a variety of work duties, to plan and direct the work of subordinates
